## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### Saint Oliver Plunket

Saint Oliver Plunket was born on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1625 in Loughcrew in County Meath.

He was the Catholic Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of All Ireland. during the period of great persecution for Catholics by the British Government.

Saint Oliver was the last victim of the so called Popish Plot and was martyred by being hung, drawn, and quartered on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 1681.

Saint Oliver was beatified in 1920 and canonised in 1975. He became the first Irish Saint in almost seven hundred years!
