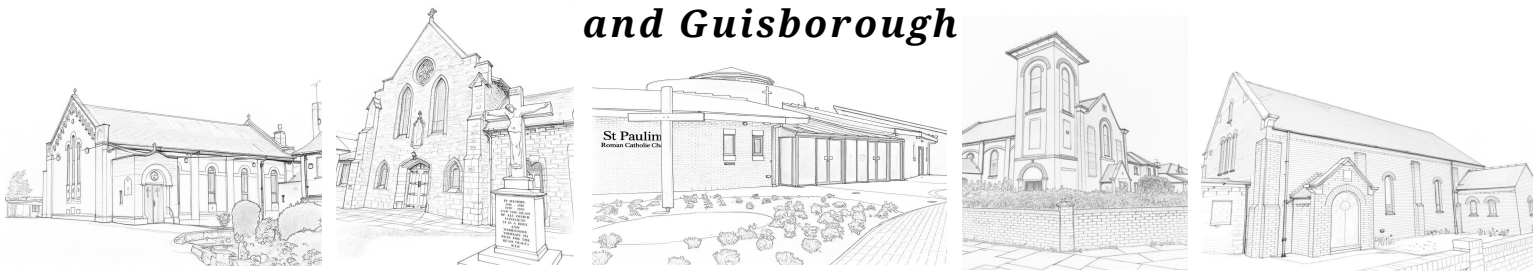

CLERGY REFLECTION:

One week after beginning our celebration of the boundless joy of the Resurrection, we are presented by the Church with a great reflection on the mercy of God. Divine Mercy Sunday reminds us that God's mercy meets us exactly where we are. In the Gospel, Thomas doubts, but instead of rejecting him, Jesus invites him to touch His wounds. Those wounds become a source of faith, not shame. In the resurrection Christ does not hide the wounds he received on Good Friday, instead He offers them as a sign of love. The message given to St. Faustina "Jesus, I trust in You" calls us to place our fears, sins, and struggles into those same wounded hands. This Sunday reassures us that no one is beyond God's mercy, and challenges us to reflect that mercy in our daily lives.

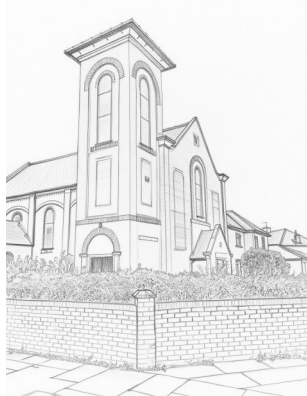
