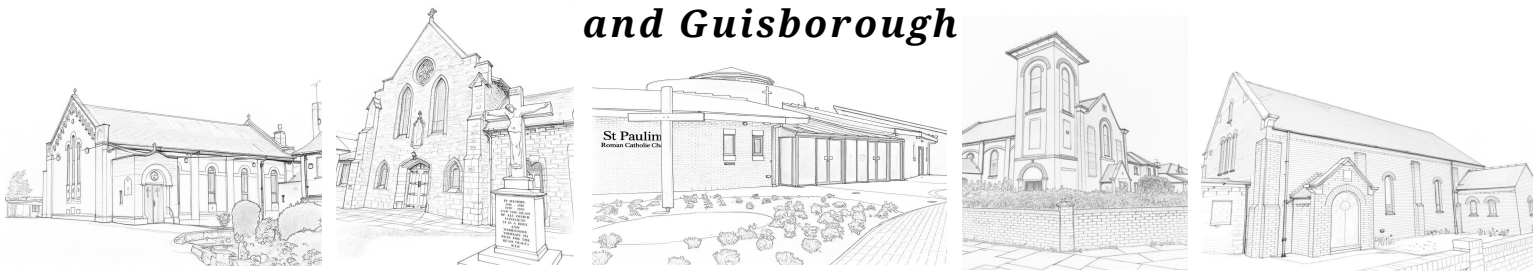

**CLERGY REFLECTION:** Pentecost Sunday represents the end of our long and wonderfully joyous Easter season. It's the culmination of God's salvific plan, the sending of his only Son to save the world through his death and resurrection, gaining for us the gift of eternal life, and finally sending us the gift of the Holy Spirit on that first Pentecost. Our readings today are all about the Holy Spirit. The 1st reading depicts an account we are all familiar with: the descent of the tongues of fire, while our 2nd reading reminds us what it means to receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The Gospel reading gives John's account of Pentecost, as Jesus himself breathes the Holy Spirit on to the disciples. We know that with God's help through the Spirit everything is possible and in the Spirit we flourish. So today is a Feast of great celebration and thanksgiving, and in many ways one which marks the birth of the Church. On Monday we return to ordinary time but with renewed vigour and enthusiasm, energised once again by the gift of the Holy Spirit to bear witness to the Good News. ~ Deacon Len

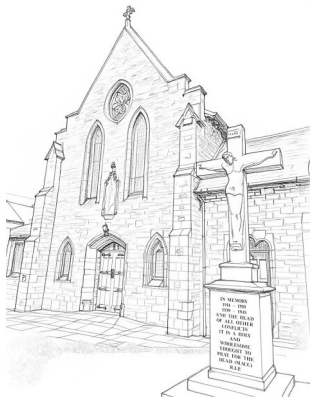
