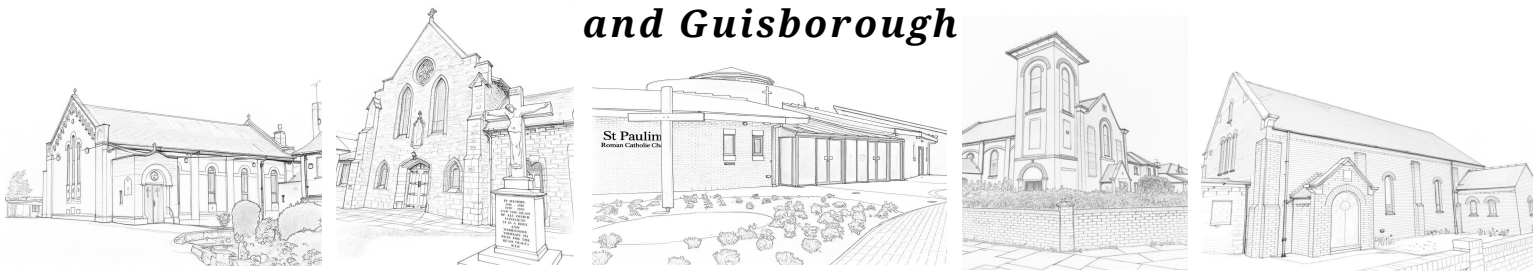

CLERGY REFLECTION:

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to reflect on the mystery of one God in three Persons: The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit. Though this mystery is beyond full human understanding, the readings reveal God as loving, merciful, and faithful. In the Gospel, we hear that "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son", reminding us that love is at the centre of the Trinity.

In the first reading, God reveals Himself to Moses as compassionate and rich in mercy. In the second reading, St. Paul encourages believers to live in peace, unity, and love. These readings show us that the Trinity is not only a mystery to believe in, but also an example to follow. We are called to reflect God's love in our families, communities, and daily lives.
