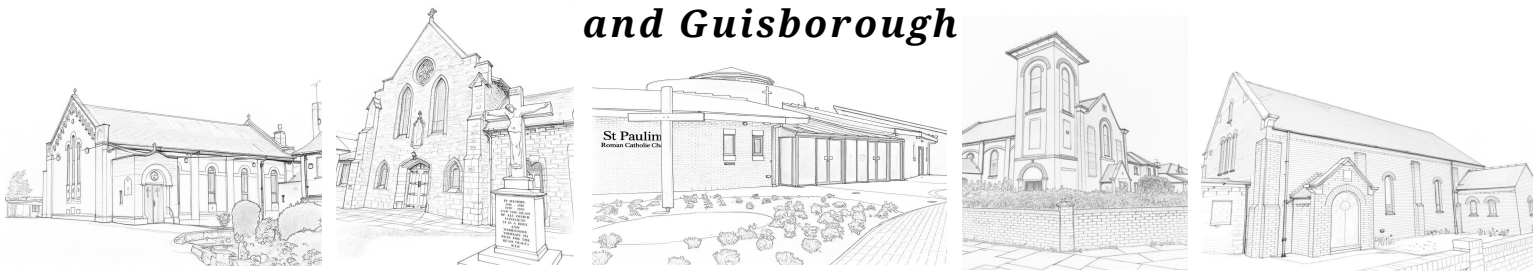

CLERGY REFLECTION:

This weekend the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi - Feast of Christ's Body and Blood. We recall and celebrate Christ's real presence body, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. This feast reminds us of a God who loves through sacrifice and offers the gift of himself "body and blood", to us as the fruit of this sacrifice. In today's readings, Moses reminded the people not to forget how God led them, fed them, and took care of them in their desert journey to the promised land. "The blessing-cup that we bless is a communion with the blood of Christ, and the bread that we break is a communion with the body of Christ". In this, St. Paul reminds us about the unity and oneness we share at the table of Christ's Body and Blood. Christ is the living bread come down from heaven; he's giving us an invitation to come share in the gift of his body and blood here below so to unite and share with him the heavenly banquet.
